Food Fraud Cases

The U.S Food & Drug Administration (FDA) has released data from an assignment related to Economically Motivated Adulteration (EMA) on honey, conducted between April 2022 and July 2023. The sampling (107 samples of imported honey) was designed to identify products that contained undeclared sweeteners less expensive than honey, such as syrups from cane and corn. 3% of samples were violative.
